






Key Factors - Average Data


Perception of Trends - All Data



The focus is on collaboration and community impact at the regional scale, drawing in surrounding smaller communities. Community investments and leadership aim to build a stronger regional system. Community is very outward and regionally, nationally and globally focused, with investments being made at a larger scale.

The economic focus is to support and strengthen existing traditional industries of agriculture, tourism and interstate service center. The local workforce and skills sets are aligned to these industries. Markets and products are heavily oriented around the existing industries.



The economic focus is on expanding new economic opportunities and embracing new technologies. The educational system aims to equip the workforce with a broad set of skills for the future workplace. There is a strong emphasis on stimulating new businesses that bring new products and services to a larger global market.

















Expected X Preferred - Cohort Data






